PASTORAL PRAYER REV. TYLER DIRKS

God, You search us and You know us. You know when we sit down and when we rise up. You discern our thoughts from afar. You are intimately aware of every area and detail of our lives, and You are acquainted with all our ways. Even before a word is on our tongue, You know it altogether. You hem us in, behind and before. Such knowledge is too wonderful for us; it is high, and we cannot attain it.

We are especially lonely these days. We are weary of isolation. We ask You to miraculously remove the pestilence, and we ask You to give us the miracle gift of perseverance. Whatever Your purpose and timing, we recognize the fantastic truth that we cannot isolate ourselves from Your Spirit. There is no season or circumstance of life that places us outside of Your presence. If we ascend to heaven, You are there. If we make our beds in Sheol, You are there. If we take the wings of the morning and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea, even there Your hand shall lead us, and Your right hand shall hold us. If
